



The Third Regiment, Inc.
April 1st, 2026, 2nd Quarter Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 8:10 PM by Vice President Alex Campbell.

Treasurers Report:

Treasurer Drew Schwartzel reported that there have been no significant changes to the budget. The Third Regiment account currently holds a balance of \$882.29.

It is noted that the 69th NY has yet to pay their dues and will not be covered until those dues are submitted to Treasurer Drew Schwartzel.

Focus Events:

Point Lookout (September 11-13, 2026):

President Alex Campbell led off the meeting with the confirmation from Point Lookout State Park that 3rd Regiment is able to host an event there on September 11th, 12th, and 13th of this year. The board all agreed that it was a beautiful site. There may be possible interest from other 3rd Regiment units as well and could be a nice opportunity. Secretary Joe Sabolek said that there may not be as high of numbers due to the other numerous events late this year such as “A Masterful Retreat” and Franklin but could be an excellent location moving forward. Good to make positive connections with different sites moving forward. We need a representative to head up communication with Point Lookout who will be attending.

1st Manassas (July 17th-19th, 2026)

Living History in Manassas Virginia. Harry Sontag of the CWHI told the 3rd Regiment and Jerry that we need to begin increasing registrations so we can field several companies. Alex Campbell said we should be producing at least two companies of men. All other details are the same as previously listed in last meeting notes. **It is encouraged that all units push their men to start registering. No date is set for a deadline and 3rd Regiment will make one themselves.**

Paynes Farm (April of 2026)

Tom Grant informed the board that there are only 5 registrations for a small picket post event that would allow us to “get our foot in the door” with the site. It will likely be cancelled. The board concurred that the site is exceptional and that we could do anything we wanted. Tom said that the site has much potential. Jerry, Joe, and Tom all said Mine Run is an underrepresented campaign and that we could make the event very much like a tactical.

Final Thoughts:

The discussion on Mine Run led into the board agreeing that we need to plan for 2027 now. Releasing our schedule early will allow for more planning and give our units within the 3rd Regiment much more time to plan and set their schedules so we can have Regiment level events. We cannot wait until January to attempt to organize for events or we will be scrambling and in a weird spot. There were suggestions from Kyle, Alex, and Jerry to have smaller meetings with the board and cadre concerning events, as well as with the units within the 3rd to ask for

their opinions and coordinate schedules for maximum participation. The Board is in agreeance.

Alex and Joe discussed bringing authenticity to Phillipi, May 28th-31st, 2026. Alex is organizing the Barbour Mt. Guard while Joe is organizing the 16th Ohio. Both units plan on conducting battlefield walks, issuing out mail, and using correct manuals. It is a fun event with a lot of opportunities. "Infiltrate with authenticity."
